Write an 800-Word Blog

Please make sure that your blog is a minimum of 800 words, is original content, and follows CEUfast's guidelines for publishing.



Upload and Submit for Review

Upload your blog to [CEUfast.com/blog/submissions](https://www.ceufast.com/blog/submissions). Once you have submitted your blog, please allow up to 60 days for CEUfast's editorial team to review it.



Receive Payment Once Blog Publishes

After your blog is determined it meets all the submission criteria, it will be published, and you will receive payment.

Blog Submission Checklist

When submitting a blog for publication, please follow the editorial guidelines.

Following these guidelines can increase your chances of acceptance and ensure your content meets publishing standards.

Please submit your blog at [CEUfast.com/blog/submissions](https://ceufast.com/blog/submissions).

- Make sure that the blog post is a minimum of 800 words. Maximum of 1,600 words. Include 2-3 resource links throughout your blog post.
- Please do not include third-party, self-affiliated promotional verbiage, explicit endorsements, or sponsored products.
- When writing the blog, make sure it is informative and reflective. Avoid using any political or religious language, as well as any potentially offensive subject matter.
- At this time, we kindly ask that all entries be in English, as our current capabilities for editing in other languages are limited.
- Please ensure that all content for blog posts is originally and authentically written, without the use of AI-generated material.

* Please keep in mind that there is no guarantee that an entry will be accepted and published; however, we will carefully review each submission to ensure that it aligns with our publishing standards and provides value to our readers.



Getting Started

1 Come up with a topic

Come up with a topic that you can be an authentic, passionate advocate for, and be a voice on that subject.

2 Create an outline

Once you have a topic, create an outline as a guide to structure your thoughts and discussions. This will help keep you organized when writing.

3 Write your blog

Now you can start writing. Remember, your blog is a source of community engagement and knowledge for nurses around the world.

4 Edit Grammar & Content

Editing your content for grammatical errors and content is crucial to ensure clear communication, maintain credibility, and enhance the impact and effectiveness of your message.



Details & FAQs

What is a blog post?

A blog post is any article, news piece, or guide that's published in the blog section of a website.

What are the criteria for the blog?

Your blog must contain a minimum of 800 words, pertain to the nursing/medical sector, and is entirely original to gain acceptance. Our editorial team at CEUfast will thoroughly check your submission for any evidence of plagiarism.

How much will I make per blog entry?

CEUfast's standard rate for blog entries is \$100 per 800-word minimum blog. For additional pay scale questions regarding longer blogs, please contact our Editor at emily.pazel@ceufast.com.

How many blog entries can I submit?

Nurse authors are welcome to submit multiple blog entries without any limitations. However, it's important to note that the acceptance and publication of an entry are not guaranteed, and payment is contingent upon publishing a blog entry rather than its mere submission.

How does payment work?

Once your blog is submitted, please allow up to 60 days for CEUfast's editorial team to review it. After your blog is determined it meets all the submission criteria, it will be published, and the author will receive payment. Payment will be sent within 7-10 business days after the blog post is published on the website.
